- Golden Pipeline LNG -
  - ✓ Tom Berger –
  - ✓ Their pipeline runs from the Sabine Pass through Texas and ends in Starks, LA
  - $\checkmark~$  It has been seven years been working on it
  - ✓ It is a Natural Gas Pipeline
  - ✓ Located in the Sabine Pass
  - ✓ 2 billion cubic ft. of natural gas
  - ✓ Its 69 miles long
  - ✓ 42" pipeline underground and 8 interconnect sites
  - ✓ MOP = 1440 PSI
  - ✓ Plan to commission in Aug./Sept. 2010
  - ✓ They have 4 tugs at their site with firefighting equipment on them
  - ✓ They have about 12 miles in Calcasieu Parish
  - ✓ Steve Andrews –
  - ✓ They have emergency shutdown units
  - $\checkmark$  Their emergency response plan is to protect employees and the public
  - ✓ Emergency Response Team consist of Golden Pass employees on the ground that response to incidents
  - ✓ 24 hrs. 365 days
  - ✓ They are trained individuals
  - ✓ Golden Pass met with the Stark Volunteer Fire Dept. last week
