- ✓ 2 billion cubic ft. of natural gas

- ✓ Its 69 miles long

- ✓ 42" pipeline underground and 8 interconnect sites

- ✓ MOP = 1440 PSI

- ✓ Plan to commission in Aug./Sept. 2010

- ✓ They have 4 tugs at their site with firefighting equipment on them

- ✓ They have about 12 miles in Calcasieu Parish
