- ✓ Reality is finding who would be the person to contact if anything go wrongs while they are working on the facility
- ✓ I-210 Project:

- Dick Gremillion, we had a GO Group Public Safety last month in June, and discussed some issues/concerns
- We will issuing a weekly situational report, gather all the traffic information for the whole region, what ongoing and going projects out to the public
- *Next step after we get the reporting approved, a detailed response training with the Emergency agencies involved*
- The construction of the bridge has been pushed back until 2017
- We are trying to advised community to use apps, ex: Waze, Google Maps and the Way to Geaux

• Greg Satterfield, Three weeks ago they had a power failure that caused three flares, they did a CAER notification and when the incident was finished did an All Clear on CAER as well

- There is a lot of Entergy in the Atlantic right now already had 4 named storms, they are looking back to 2005
- Rob Daughdril, Just start getting your preparedness together
- Get your Emergency plans together, know you plan and go over your plan
- We have been meeting with the worker villages coming to the area about their *Emergency plans and make sure they know it and make sure they have an evacuation route*
- Dick Gremillion, if we do have to evacuation the 2-10 project will not be an issue
