- Treasury Report: \$\$100,514.80
- **Roger Erikson,** if any facility would like the NWS service to come out and do a Hurricane presentation or Severe weather you can contact them to schedule one
- Presentation from Paul DeStout, regarding the Siren Malfunction March 9, 2017:
 - ✓ The calls we started to get were around 10:30am. Callers were stating that the siren sound was a High/Low sound.
 - ✓ Foul smell was reported shortly after that.
 - ✓ Social Media reports of Axiall South Plant C evacuation because of a leak/explosion and a crane falling with one injury
 - ✓ The conclusion of the Event: there were three separate events contributed to this event
 - Axiall South had an evacuation drill in Plant C from 0915 1015
 - Citgo was restarting their plant after a major power failure and stream was pushed to the flares possibly causing the foul smell
 - LRC was making repairs to a siren and during the final testing of the repair accidently set off multiple sirens from LCFD
 - ✓ There was never a chemical emergency
 - ✓ OEP did a Hotwash on 3/10/2017 at 1046
 - ✓ Called LRC to determine how to avoid this in the future
 - Met with LRC (Garret) to get explanation 3/10/2017 1400
 - Test code was misinterpreted as a signal 8digit/10digit.
 - \circ This happen when installing Vinton sirens several years ago.
 - Process was place so this would not happen again by setting up area codes for the sirens
 - *Reason: Sirens that were set off were set up on wrong area code.*
 - Fix: Make as many sirens 10 digits as possible
 - OHSEP requested that LRC contact E911 to page out that work is being done on the sirens.
- Presentation from Jason French and Andrew Chartrand for the Tellurian project:
 - ✓ Driftwood LNG project: Land: 1,000-acre site near Lake Charles, LA
 - ✓ Facility: 26 mtpa LNG facility
 - ✓ Five LNG plants, each made up of one gas pre-treatment unit and four liquefaction units with nominal capacity of 1.3 mtpa each (5.2 mtpa/plant) + 20 trains
 - ✓ *Three 235,000 m3 net full-containment LNG storage tanks*

- ✓ Three marine loading berths designed to accommodate LNG ships up to 216,000 m3
- ✓ *Pipeline:* 96-*mile pipeline*
- ✓ 4 bcf/d of capacity
- ✓ Multiple interconnects
- ✓ They are in the application process of filing with FERC
- ✓ Hope to start construction in 2018
- ✓ *First LNG plant operational will be in 2022*
- ✓ Full pipeline operations in 2023
- ✓ All LNG plants in 2025
- ✓ Current in the draft form of the Emergency Operations Plan
- ✓ Will be sending out a copy to the LEPC for any comments
- ✓ Their ERP will be a "living" document that will continue to be developed in coordination with agencies and groups until operations commence
- ✓ ERP content, Designated contacts with state and local emergency response agencies
- Procedures for prompt notification of appropriate local officials and emergency response agencies based on the level and severity of potential hazard
- Procedures for notifying residents and recreational users within areas of potential hazard
- Evacuation routes/methods for residents and public use areas that are within any transient hazard areas along the route of LNG marine transit
- ✓ Locations of permanent sirens and other warning devices
- Cost sharing plan identifying mechanisms for funding project-specific security/emergency management costs that would be imposed on state and local agencies

 - ✓ Also the next meeting discuss about replacing Robin Martin, and Jerry Merchant on the Budget committee
