- III. Sasol Review: July 30, 2017
 - It occurred in their East plant which is the operating plant not the construction plant
 - It was in the alcohol unit
 - A tubing pulled apart when pressurized releasing Alkyls and solvent which caused the fire
 - Sasol ERT was called out
 - It was in the oldest unit that was built in 1961
 - 1 Sasol employee was injured and is still under doctor care
 - No offsite impact and it was self-contained
 - It was cleared July 31, 2017
 - *Larry Johnson (USCG), Discussion on Fire Fighting capabilities for the Calcasieu Channel*
 - What happens if and when the ship channel is blocked for so many days because of a fire incident, like the T/V Veracruz that had a fire in September 2017
 - If we could get a committee back up and running and discuss what we could do
 - We have assets in the area, just need to get them together
 - Steve Couch will revisit and include Mutual Aid and the LEPC to see what we can do
 - Most tankers have a fire plan in place but they sign contracts with companies that are not close to the area, which if they have to call them it would take time to get to the scene.
 - Also who's jurdiscations does it fall under, most are under the volunteer fire departments and they don't have the equipment for that
 - If an agency is called to respond who pays the cost of the bills
 - William Hover, Will give us a presentation on CERT organization
 - They fall under the Calcasieu Medical Reserve Corps
 - they can respond to help with incidents but are not allowed passed the hot zone
 - The train all their volunteers with First Aid/CPR
 - They do not self-respond they have to be requested through Angela Jouett office
