- ✓ **Lyondell/Basell** Greg Satterfield, discuss about their ongoing siren testing every day of the week
 - They are in the process of upgrading their sirens and will be testing them M-F until August September of this year.
 - The sirens have 74 different messages that they test
 - Will send a letter to Richard McGuire, Mason Lindsay, and Megan Powell with the schedule.
 - Have all facilities send a schedule and time of when they do their testing of their sirens
 - Can use the OEP ringdown system and notified the community of the testing
 - ✓ CAER: Dick Gremillion, will discuss the CAER procedures
 - The two important questions; What to report? How to report it?
 - Must be reported immediately if it meets one or more of the following;
 - Causes any injury requiring hospitalization or any fatality
 - 2. Results in fire or explosion which could reasonably be expected to affect the public safety beyond the boundaries of the facility
 - 3. Exceeds the reportable quantity during a 24 hour period when that reportable quantity could reasonably be expected to escape beyond the site of the facility.
 - Some report to the LEPC and think that is 911, when they need to call 911 first
 - Depends on the type of release rather they have to report to NRC
 - Their first call should be to 911, but most facilities call the hotline or NRC first
