 - A valid State Drivers License and company issued photo ID.
 - MARKED COMPANY VEHICLES (Company should have standardized markings).
 - Letter of Access (LOA) issued by company (with verified phone number) stating that the bearer and vehicle is an authorized responder to the event.
 - Most companies no longer mark their vehicles for all management personnel.
 - What about getting OEP to put a letter together to send to all the agencies involved, with what is the local requirements for the Parish.
 - Inget, egrets are determined by each Parish and following the Re-entry guidelines.
