- LNG World Summit
  - 1. Delphin FID Q4 2022
  - 2. LC LNG Energy Transfer signed an additional contract making a total of 4 contracts

- now signed. LC LNG is fully permitted and FID Q4 2022 if not before.
- **3.** Commonwealth has contracted 100% of capacity \$4.5 B FID announcement is expected in June.
- **4.** Venture CP#2 under construction by Kiewit. CP#1 train #8 permitted to start production. Venture Geismar FID approved \$13B project to start Q4.
- **5.** Cameron LNG/Sempra awarded EPC to Zachary. Addition several companies signed a contract to build a \$3B carbon capture facility at Cameron LNG in Hackberry to capture the carbon released during liquidation.

- **1.** Chevron Orange was \$8B now \$16B announcement is scheduled for Q1 2022 but is expected anytime. W T Ballard civil site prep contractor was told to put an additional 75 pieces of equipment on site to expedite civil prep.
  - **2.** OCI Beaumont \$5B expansion with Jacob's as EPC.
  - **3.** Tallow (sp?) in JV with Chevron to build a carbon capture facility in Port Arthur near Sabine Pass.
  - **4.** Talliespin Industrial is building a \$3B steam reformer in Geismar.
  - **5.** Howard Energy is taking an idle facility in Corpus Christi and converting it to Carbon Capture.
  - **6.** Modular Industrial Solutions is the GC for Arbor Renewable Fuels to build a bio diesel facility near Nederland, TX.
  - 7. Lake Charles Methanol \$4B methanol plant on Bayou Inde Rd. Westlake announcement to start is imminent.
  - US Corps of Engineers:
  - **1.** Enable Lina LA to Golden Pass. Pipeline and compressor stations.
