- **LNG World Summit**
  1. *Delphin – FID Q4 2022*
  2. *LC LNG - Energy Transfer signed an additional contract making a total of 4 contracts*

*now signed. LC LNG is fully permitted and FID – Q4 2022 if not before.*

3. *Commonwealth – has contracted 100% of capacity \$4.5 B FID announcement is expected in June.*
4. *Venture – CP#2 under construction by Kiewit. CP#1 train #8 permitted to start production. Venture Geismar FID approved \$13B project to start Q4.*
5. *Cameron LNG/Sempra – awarded EPC to Zachary. Addition several companies signed a contract to build a \$3B carbon capture facility at Cameron LNG in Hackberry to capture the carbon released during liquidation.*

• **Plants:**

1. *Chevron Orange – was \$8B now \$16B announcement is scheduled for Q1 2022 but is expected anytime. W T Ballard civil site prep contractor was told to put an additional 75 pieces of equipment on site to expedite civil prep.*
  2. *OCI Beaumont - \$5B expansion with Jacob's as EPC.*
  3. *Tallow (sp?) – in JV with Chevron to build a carbon capture facility in Port Arthur near Sabine Pass.*
  4. *Talliespin Industrial – is building a \$3B steam reformer in Geismar.*
  5. *Howard Energy – is taking an idle facility in Corpus Christi and converting it to Carbon Capture.*
  6. *Modular Industrial Solutions – is the GC for Arbor Renewable Fuels to build a bio diesel facility near Nederland, TX.*
  7. *Lake Charles Methanol \$4B methanol plant on Bayou Inde Rd. Westlake announcement to start is imminent.*
