IV. New Business:

- Sasol Review:
 - Sasol representatives in attendance, Pieter Potgieter, Ryan Novak, Sarah Hughes, and Scot Tyler
 - Presentation on the recent incident at their Zielger Ethylene unit back on October 15, 2022.
 - There was a fire in that unit, it was contained and isolated to that one unit.
 - The reason of the fire was it was during a turnaround, and they were in the process of a transfer from one unit to another. The valve failed and the line ruptured.
 - Operations activated the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and the Emergency Response Team (ERT) responded as well. CAER notification was made. Sasol notified CPSO, and CPSO issued the Shelter in Place for the safety of the traffic traveling down Houston River Road. Everything was on site, no off site.
 - All required regulatory notifications were made.
 - Was about a 9-minute respond.
 - Product that was the issue was, Aluminum Tri-Ethyl, LPA Solvent, Thermal olefins
 - Post Incident team, Incident Investigation, Fire Damage and Recovery teams did a thorough investigation.
 - ERT was activated, EOC pulled in stakeholders.
 - They had a de-belief; Water had been present in the hydrotesting of the equipment and that was the cause of the fire.
 - No injuries were reported.

 - World LNG Conference at George R Brown convention center Houston, May 31 June 1. 12 LNG companies attending.
 - Projects now being considered for SW Louisiana and SW Texas in next 30 months total \$171 Billion and now Anticipate needing over 50,000 construction workers.
 - Sempra LNG Port Arthur \$10.5 Billion 100 permanent, 8,000 construction.
 - Golden Pass LNG Port Arthur \$10 Billion 3,500 permanent, 8,000 Construction.
 - Driftwood LNG Carlyss \$16 Billion 400 permanent 9000 construction. Bechtel and Bo Mac on site now.
 - Lake Charles LNG \$10 billion 8000 Construction. Energy Transfer expects FID in Q4 2023.
 - Chevron orange \$8.5 Billion 100 permanent 7000 construction. Contractor bid pkgs being sent out now.
 - Chenier LNG apply to FERC for more production capacity construction.
 - Exxon Mobil Beaumont \$6 billion 1000 permanent 2000 Construction.
 - OCI methanol Beaumont \$5 billion 100 permanent 3000 construction.
 - Valero Port Arthur \$3 Billion 400 permanent 2500 construction.
 - Entergy Bridge City \$5 Billion 200 permanent 2000 construction.
 - Arbor biofuels Beaumont \$3 billion 200 permanent 1500 construction.
 - Venture LNG CP2 project McDermott GC sending out bid pkgs. SCG&E site on Monkey Island now location for Vesture LNG CP2.
 - Tellurian purchased G2 zero net LNG on Monday February 27. Tellurian now owns Driftwood and G2LNG.
 - \$2.1 Billion Delphin LNG ship under construction. Process is Black & Viech. GC not

announced.

- Commonwealth LNG waiting on one more FERC signature to release \$60 million contract for site prep. Anticipate release second half of March 2023.
- \$8 Billion Chevron Orange has Kiewet, Burns & Mac, Zachary and S&B working on scope and bid pkgs.
- \$10 Billion expansion by Bechtel at Port Arthur LNG mobilizing with office trailers and equipment.
- \$1.5 Billion carbon capture project Cameron LNG to Hackberry strategic reserve for injection.
- \$4.5 Million Air Products Port Arthur Carbon Capture.
- \$98 Million mill and wood yard expansion in Hodge Louisiana by West Rock.
- Greenfield sawmill construction planned for Bon Weir.
- State of Texas biofuel project to provide jet fuel to LAX, to be built in Bon Weir waiting on permit approvals.
- LG Chemicals purchased 200 acres in Port Arthur for industrial construction.
